

Dean McLeod, Sherwood Park, Alberta

Dean grew up on a wheat farm, where the prairie wind and big sky seared his soul. The "Untouched Beauty" series of paintings was partly begun with a quote: "In anything at all, perfection is finally attained not when there is no longer anything left to add, but when there is no longer anything to take away."

Rick Berg, Crossfield, Alberta

Rick is a self-taught artist who works mainly in oils. His images are clearly influenced by the special light, landscapes, and wildlife found between the prairies and the mountains. Long known for his skilled portrayal of wildlife, Rick's more recent work shows an increasing sensitivity to light and colour often expressed in images of urban houses, gardens, city parks, golf courses and rural landscapes.

Lois Bauman, Calgary, Alberta

Lois has taken the wild landscape around her and reinterpreted it through her art. Her oil paintings, rendered in an impressionistic style using loose brush strokes in brilliant colors, depict the landscapes of Western Canada. Her work is frequently compared to one of Canada's favorite artists from the Group of Seven, Tom Thompson.

Herb Sellin, Calgary, Alberta

Herb attended the Alberta College of Art in Calgary and has been painting full time in Calgary for the past 35 years. His Landscapes and Portraits grace the walls of hundreds of offices and homes throughout North America and Europe. Internationally he is best known for his life-size portrait of the former Prime Minister of Canada, the late Rt. Hon. John G. Diefenbaker.

Iryna Zayarny, Calgary, Alberta

Iryna was born and raised in Ukraine. Her works portray a wide variety of subjects, ranging from landscapes to still life to portraits. Her works possess a strong sense of realism, bold contrast and soft color values, which result in striking images with abundant layering of detail. Iryna's dedication to art drove her to found the art group Silhouette, with the aim of bringing a different and unique cultural perspective to the Canadian art landscape.

Bill Dixon, High River, Alberta

More than seventy years of preparation have brought Bill to where he is now, to what he considers the finale. He has traveled, without hurry, through the vast and loveable place that is Western Canada. From Sooke to Kenora, from Ocean Shore to Cambrian Shield his eyes have breathed this country into his soul so that he may paint it boldly and richly.
